**5. God's love is the one thing that won't change this year:** People will disappoint us and let us down. Circumstances will constantly change and often unexpectedly, but God's love will always remain steady and unshaken. Romans 8:38-39 38: "***For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, 39 neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.***"
